### Gaming News

Donations for March totaled \$5455.00. This included \$200 to the Fargo VA Medical Center, \$900 to send 3 boys to Boys State, \$400 to the Darkhouse Association, \$400 to the St. John's Church youth group, \$400 to the First Responders, \$300 to the Hubbard County Posse, \$400 to the Antique Tractor Club, \$400 to Hubbard County, \$1500 to the Food Shelf, \$155 to the Youth Drug Prevention program, and \$400 to the S.A.L. donation to the Patriot Assistance Dogs program. Gaming funds were also used to pay the clubs utilities: total of \$1,469.24.
